Yet, so far as the author is aware, the little attempt was the first of its kind; and certainly, so far as he was concerned, it seemed not unlikely to be the last. As of John Wray's own parentage and family, so of his widow and children after their return to England, the writer knew nothing. What inquiries he had made proved unavailing; and the brief history soon began to mingle with the stream of things behind, which are on the way to being forgotten.
